Scheme.

CHARITY COMMISSION.

In the matter of the Charity comprising the gift of W. Symington and Company Limited, for the benefit of the inhabitants of the former Urban District of Market Harborough, in the County of Leicestershire, regulated by a conveyance dated the 2nd July 1946; and In the matter of the Charities Act, 1960.

THE CHARITY COMMISSIONERS FOR ENGLAND AND WALES HERMBY ORDER that the following Scheme be approved and established:-

SCHEME.

- 1. Administration of Charity. The above-mentioned Charity and the property thereof shall be administered and managed subject to and in conformity with the provisions of the above-mentioned conveyance dated the 2nd July 1946 as affected by the provisions of this Scheme under the title of the Howard Watson Symington Memorial Charity by the Harborough District Council, the Trustees thereof.
- 2. Sale. The Trustees may subject to the authority of any further Order or Orders of the Charity Commissioners sell the land and buildings specified in the schedule hereto and belonging to the Charity and may do and execute all proper acts and assurances for carrying such sale into effect.

- 3. Proceeds of sale. The clear proceeds of such sale as aforesaid shall be invested in trust for the Charity.
- 4. Letting. The Trustees may let the said land and buildings provided that they shall not without the sanction of the Commissioners or a competent court create any tenancy wholly or partly in consideration of a fine or for a term ending more than 22 years after it is granted or for less than the best rent obtainable.
- 5. Application of income. (1) The Trustees shall apply the clear income of the Charity for charitable purposes for the general benefit of the inhabitants of the former Urban District of Market Harborough in one or more of the following ways, or in such other ways as the Trustees think fit:-
 - (a) in relieving the aged, impotent and poor;
 - (b) in relieving distress and sickness;
 - (c) in providing and supporting with the object of improving the conditions of life for the said inhabitants in the interests of social welfare facilities for recreation and other leisure time occupation;
 - (d) in providing and supporting educational facilities.
- (2) The Trustees may apply income for charitable purposes as aforesaid either directly or by way of donations or subscriptions to institutions or organisations which apply or which undertake in return to apply the whole or part of their income for such charitable purposes.
- 6. Questions under Scheme. Any question as to the construction of this Scheme or as to the regularity or the validity of any acts done or about to be done under this Scheme shall be determined by the Commissioners upon such application made to them for the purpose as they think sufficient.

SCHEDULE.

Land containing 0.463 acres or thereabouts situate at Market Harborough in the County of Leicestershire having a frontage of 90 feet or thereabouts on the east to Northampton Road and a depth therefrom of 221 feet or thereabouts with the buildings thereon known as Brooklands being part of the land comprised in the above-mentioned conveyance dated the 2nd July 1946 and made between W. Symington and Company Limited of the one part and The Market Harborough Urban District Council of the other part.
